(c) At all General or Sub-Committee meetings the Chairman shall have a casting vote as well as a deliberative vote. The President and Secretary shall be members ex-officio of all Sub-Committees.

(d) That no motion shall be accepted on committee which is contrary to a decision of an Annual General Meeting.

(e) That the Secy. be authorised to call a meeting of committee at any time.

(f) That any member of Committee absenting himself from three consecutive committee meetings without sufficient reason will be deemed to have vacated his office by default and the Committee will appoint a new member in his place. Any member of Committee unable to attend a meeting called, will be required to tender a written apology to the Secy. or President, and where appropriate submit his report.

(g) The retiring General Committee shall, as far as is within their power, present to the A.G.M. a list of recommendations, one for each office and convenership. These recommendations can be opposed at the A.G.M. by other nominees.

ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION.

6. That the Annual Subscription shall be £1 or if under 19 years of age on 1st January, 10/- or if under 17 years of age on 1st January, 5/- which sum shall be due and payable on 1st January in each year and must be paid before participating in club races.

In the case of members joining on or after 1st November their subscription shall be valid until 31st December in the following year.

LIFE MEMBERSHIP.

Members having paid five consecutive Senior Annual Subscriptions shall be granted Life Membership on payment of £4 4/-.

RESIGNATIONS.

That any member desiring to resign from the club must give written notice of resignation to the Secretary accompanied by all monies due to the club and any property held by him, failing which he shall be liable for the ensuing year's subscription.

Members other than Life Members and at the discretion of the General Committee Past Presidents and/or Past Secretaries who for any reason other than illness or due to National Service commitments absent themselves from the club or its activities for more than two years without resigning or paying an annual subscription shall be deemed to have severed their connection with the club and their names will be removed from the roll of the club's active members.

In the event of any such inactive past-member wishing to renew his association with the club it will be necessary for him to make formal application in writing to the Secretary who will submit the application for the consideration of the General Committee at its next meeting. On acceptance of the renewal of the membership the reinstated member will be required to pay a subscription for the year following that in which he did not officially intimate his resignation together with any prior arrears of subscription and also the subscription for the current year.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.

7. (a) That the Annual General Meeting shall be held on the first Friday in Sept. of each year and shall be called by circular 7 clear days before meeting. The reports of the Secretary and the Treasurer shall be submitted, and office-bearers appointed, also two auditors (not members of committee) shall be appointed to audit the club books and accounts for the year. Twenty to form a quorum.

FINANCIAL YEAR.

(b) That the financial year will end on 30th June of each year by which date all outstanding accounts and monies due to the club must be paid.

SPECIAL MEETINGS, Etc.

(c) That Special General Meetings may be called at any time should the Committee deem them necessary, or on a requisition signed by fifteen members being presented to the Secy. together with the sum of five shillings (5/-) which sum in the event of the requisition being upheld, will be refunded.

(d) That no alteration to rule shall take place, except at an Annual General Meeting; intimation of proposed alteration to be made to the Secretary in writing not later than 21st July in each year. Such proposals of alteration shall be included in circular calling meeting.

PROTESTS.

8. That all protests must be made in writing and signed by member or members protesting, and be in the hands of Secretary within three days after the race.

MISCONDUCT.

9. That any member violating the rules or guilty of misconduct may be expelled from the club by vote of a majority of the Committee. The expelled will have the right to appeal to a General Meeting called at his (or her) request within fourteen days.

CROSS-COUNTRY RUNS.

1. That cross-country races be held on Saturdays or on such days as the Committee may fix from the beginning of October until the end of March. This period may be extended or curtailed should the necessity arise.

2. That on all official runs, packs will be arranged by the club captain, who shall appoint pace-makers and whips, the latter to be in charge. On receiving a signal from the whip, the pace-maker and pack will stop, and will not resume running until instructed by the whip.

3. That any member not adhering to the rule shall be reported to the Committee and may be dealt with according to rule nine (9).

4. That any member not desiring to go out with an official pack must inform the club captain and explain his (or her) proposed trail.

5. That all members are expected to support the management for the time being.

6. That all runs take place wet or dry.

RULES OF TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

1. Only fully paid up members are eligible to compete.
2. The entry fee of 1/- (boys 6d.) per event must have been paid.
3. Medals will be awarded to all winners except as stated in clause 5.
4. If only one competitor enters for an event, the event will not take place.
5. If more than one competitor applies but only one competes he will be required to reach his standard and for seniors the gold standard before he is eligible for a winners medal.

In the case of the 100 yards where no standards have been laid down the decision as to whether a medal is to be awarded will rest with the Sports Committee.

6. All Cups and Trophies should be returned to the Sports Convener at least 30 days before the commencement of the Championships.
7. Standard Certificates will be issued where appropriate within four weeks of the conclusion of the Championships.
8. In all field events except the High Jump and Pole Vault four attempts will be permitted.
