CLYDESDALE HARRIERS.

Rules.

- I.—That the Club be called the "CLYDESDALE HARRIERS."
II.—That the object of the Club be the promotion of Amateur Athletics generally, and Cross-Country Running in particular.
III.—That the general management of the Club be vested in a Committee not exceeding Twenty-Four Members, of whom Fifteen shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting of the Club, including, at least, a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Captain, and Vice-Captain; the remaining Members to be elected by the Committee and by the Sections (one from each Section). Seven Members to form a quorum.

IV.—That each Candidate for election, upon filling up a form (on which the Rules of the Club are printed) declaring that he is an amateur, and that he will abide by the Laws of the Club and of the S.A.A.A., shall be proposed by one Member and seconded by another, after which his name will be submitted to the Committee, and, if agreed upon, passed. Any Member of Committee shall have the power of demanding a Ballot in the case of any Candidate. One black ball in four to exclude.

V.—That the Annual Subscription for Ordinary Members be Two Shillings and Sixpence, payable on the 1st of October in each year; Honorary Members, Five Shillings; and that the Subscription for Life Members be One Guinea. New Members' Subscriptions must be paid within One Month from the date of notice from the Secretary that their application has been passed, otherwise their election may be declared null and void.

VI.—That the Treasurer shall place before the Committee the names of all Members one month in Arrears for Subscriptions or other moneys, the Committee then having the power to erase the names of such Members from the Books, as well as to enforce payment of such Subscriptions, and no one whose Subscription has been allowed to fall in arrears shall be entitled to any of the rights and privileges of Members of the Club.

VII.—That any Member intending to withdraw from the Club shall give written notice to the Secretary before the Annual General Meeting, or be liable for another year's Subscription.

VIII.—That any Member violating the Rules of the Club or of the S.A.A.A., or doing anything prejudicial to the interests of either, may be expelled from the Club by the votes of two-thirds of the full Committee.

IX.—That the uniform of the Club be Black Knickers and White Jersey, and that the Club Badge (a Horn and Whip, with the motto, "Excelsior,") be worn on the left breast at Athletic Sports, and the Gate Badge on back at Cross-Country Runs. (Members are specially requested to enter under the name of the Club at Athletic Meetings.)

X.—That the Committee shall appoint an Advising Board of experienced members to confer with and advise the Secretary as to matters requiring to be dealt with by said Committee, and generally to watch over the interests of the Club. The Committee shall also allot the management of the Head Quarters' Districts to certain of its members, who will look after said Districts, and assist the Secretary and Treasurer, so far as these are concerned, the Section Committees appointing their own District managers, and otherwise looking after the immediate business of their Sections. The Committees shall also appoint a Business Committee and any other Sub-Committees which they may consider advisable, and have full power to fill up vacancies in the General Committee and act for the Club (except to alter Rules), the majority in all cases to decide, the Chairman or President of the Club, however, having the power to appeal to a full Special General Committee Meeting. Proxies to be allowed at such Special Meetings only. That the Meetings of Committee be held on the first Thursday of each month, or as near that date as possible, at least two days' notice to be given by the Secretary when, together with other current business, the Minutes of the Advising Board and of the Business and other Sub-Committees, as well as the Treasurer's Financial Statement up to the end of the previous month will be read and considered.

XI.—That the Annual General Meeting be held early in September, and called by notice in at least one weekly athletic paper, and in one of the Glasgow evening newspapers not less than ten days before such meeting. The Reports of the Secretary and Treasurer

shall be submitted, and the Office-bearers and Committee (with Auditor to act in conjunction with one appointed by the Committee) appointed for the ensuing year. Twenty-five members shall form a quorum; a majority to decide. The Chairman shall have the power to appeal to a Special General Meeting on any special business, at which there must be fifty members, either personally or by proxy.

XII.—That a Special General Meeting may be called by the Committee, or by any ten members, or (in the above special case) by the Chairman on giving notice to the Secretary, who shall call the meeting in the same manner as the A.G.M.

XIII.—That these Rules be annexed to the Forms of Election and inserted in the Club's "Annual," and that no alteration in, or addition to, the Rules be made except at the Annual General Meeting, or at a Special Meeting called for that purpose. Ten days' notice of such alteration to be given to the Secretary.

Cross-Country Regulations.

I.—That Cross-Country Runs be held on Saturdays, from the 1st of October to the end of February, or on such dates as the Committee may fix.

II.—That the Club when out for a run shall be under the management of the Captain or Vice-Captain, or Senior Member of Committee present, who shall appoint a Pace-Maker, and Whip for the control of each pack.

III.—That no one, when out for a run, shall be allowed to go ahead of the Pace-Maker, unless the run be a racing run, or the signal be given by the Pace-Maker for a race home.

IV.—That every member of the Club is expected to wear the Club Uniform at the Club Runs, and to support the management for the time being.

V.—That Office-Bearers and Members of Committee wear distinctive badges at Club Runs.

NOTES

FROM THE

Seventh Annual Report of the Club.

THE number of Members on the Roll at last ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING totalled 855, while this year's Report shewed the Membership to be 824. This apparent decrease may be explained by the fact that the Committee, after last Annual General Meeting, struck off the Roll a large proportion of Members who had fallen in arrears with their subscriptions, and whose names served no real purpose in being kept on. Since then, however, considerably over 100 new Members have been enrolled, while numerous applications for Membership are always being made.

Encouraging reports have been received from Dumbartonshire, Greenock, and Coatbridge, and South

Lanark Sections, between whom and Headquarters the most cordial relations continue to exist. The management of these Sections is, with one or two exceptions, in the same hands as in former seasons, and it may confidently be expected that their success in the forthcoming season will be equal to, if it does not surpass, that of past years.

Twenty-five runs—exclusive of evening runs—were indulged in last year; the Preliminary Run being with the Coatbridge Section at Coatbridge; and the Opening Run with all Sections at Victoria Baths, when there was the usual large and enthusiastic gathering. The runs during the season were fairly well attended; and one Member, M. Leggat, jun., obtained the Badge awarded for best attendance, he having turned out on every occasion.

On 10th October last year the twenty miles Cycling Handicap and Championship was held at Newton Mearns, and resulted in the Handicap being won by J. Bennett, while R. A. Vogt secured the Championship.

During the season five Cross-Country Handicaps—exclusive of Section Handicaps—and a Section and Headquarters Team Contest were decided, viz.:—

Five miles (Novice), won by J. Dobbins.

Five miles (Open), won by J. Naismith.

Seven miles (Open), won by Alf. M'Arthur.

Seven miles (Headquarters), won by W. Rennie.

Team Contest (Seven miles)—1st, Coatbridge; 2nd, Vice-Captain's Team; and 3rd, Captain's Team (both Headquarters); first man home, J. Stavert.

Ten Miles Handicap and Club Championship:—

Handicap, won by George Brown.

Championship, won by Andrew Hannah, jun.

The usual Section Handicaps also took place throughout the season, at which several promising runners made their debut.

In the S.C.C.U. Junior Cross-Country Championship, at Paisley, on 6th February last, the Club supplied the individual winner in P. T. Lewis, out of nearly 120 Competitors, while in the Team Competition we were successful in obtaining second position. This result is all the more gratifying when it is remembered that the

Team was composed entirely of young runners, who had not—unlike many of those in the opposing Teams—before run in a Championship. In the Senior Championship, held at Edinburgh on 12th March, we were not only successful in reversing our defeat of last year, but we also retained the honour of providing the first man home (a distinction which has always belonged to the Club) in Charles Pennycook, while A. Hannah, jun., took second place. The other Members who were placed in the first six of the Team were—M. Reid, J. Naismith, P. T. Lewis, and Geo. Brown, respectively.

Sports Meetings were held by the Club in May and July at Ibrox Park, and from an Athletic point of view were most successful; but from a combination of causes—chiefly a great Political Demonstration held on the day of our July Meeting—we regret that the Meetings resulted in a financial loss. The Meeting on 2nd July will be remembered chiefly on account of the magnificent performances of W. H. Morton, of the Salford Harriers, who broke the Scotch records in the One Mile and Two Miles Flat Races, for N. A. M'Leod's record in the 220 yards, and W. Malcolm's record in the Half-Mile Flat Races, as also for the fine Exhibition of Bicycle Riding by E. Leitch, of the London Polytechnic Club,

who succeeded in breaking the existing Record for the Half-Mile.

As in previous seasons our Members have greatly distinguished themselves on the track, the number of prizes won being much in excess of any former year. Amongst others we might mention the exceptional form of D. R. M'Culloch, 100 yards and Quarter-Mile Champion of the year; R. Mitchell, Half-Mile Champion; and W. Malcolm, Half-Mile Record Holder, all of whose performances have been stamped with a brilliancy and consistency hardly equalled by any other runners at these distances, while in Cycling, R. A. Vogt and J. M'Laren have so distinguished themselves that their names are known throughout the Athletic world as riders of the highest class.

And now, in order that the success of the season on which we are now entered may be attained, the Committee would impress on *all Members* the great necessity of their combining with the Committee towards this end. Individual effort is at all times commendable, but we must also remember the old saying that "*Union is Strength*." We must not forget that we have a great reputation to sustain, and it rests, not with the Committee

alone, but with every Member of the Club, to assist in maintaining that reputation, and to keep untarnished the name and fame which the Club has earned for itself, and to shew to the world that we are determined to uphold the motto of our Club—

"EXCELSIOR."
