CLYDESDALE HARRIERS.

Rules.

I.—That the Club be called the "CLYDESDALE HARRIERS."

II.—That the object of the Club be the promotion of Amateur Athletics generally, and Cross-Country Running in particular.

III.—That the general management of the Club be vested in a Committee not exceeding Twenty-Four Members, of whom Fifteen shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting of the Club, including, at least, a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Captain, and Vice-Captain; the remaining Members to be elected by the Committee and by the Sections (one from each Section). Seven Members to form a quorum.

IV.—That each Candidate for election, upon filling up a form (on which the Rules of the Club are printed) declaring that he is an amateur, and that he will abide by the Laws of the Club and of the S.A.A.A., shall be proposed by one Member and seconded by another, after which his name will be submitted to the Committee, and, if agreed upon, passed. Any Member of Committee shall have the power of demanding a Ballot in the case of any Candidate. One black ball in four to exclude.

V.—That the Annual Subscription for Ordinary Members be Two Shillings and Sixpence, payable on the 1st of October in each year; Honorary Members, Five Shillings; and that the Subscription for Life Members be One Guinea. New Members' Subscriptions must be paid within One Month from the date of notice from the Secretary that their application has been passed, otherwise their election may be declared null and void.

VI.—That the Treasurer shall place before the Committee the names of all Members one month in Arrears for Subscriptions or other moneys, the Committee then having the power to erase the names of such Members from the Books, as well as to enforce payment of such Subscriptions, and no one whose Subscription has been allowed to fall in arrears shall be entitled to any of the rights and privileges of Members of the Club.

VII.—That any Member intending to withdraw from the Club shall give written notice to the Secretary before the Annual General Meeting, or be liable for another year's Subscription.

VIII.—That any Member violating the Rules of the Club or of the S.A.A.A., or doing anything prejudicial to the interests of either, may be expelled from the Club by the votes of two-thirds of the full Committee.

IX.—That the uniform of the Club be Black Knickers and White Jersey, and that the Club Badge (a Horn and Whip, with the motto, "Excelsior,") be worn on the left breast at Athletic Sports, and the Gate Badge on back at Cross-Country Runs. (Members are specially requested to enter under the name of the Club at Athletic Meetings.)

X.—That the Committee shall appoint an Advising Board of experienced members to confer with and advise the Secretary as to matters requiring to be dealt with by said Committee, and generally to watch over the interests of the Club. The Committee shall also allot the management of the Head Quarters' Districts to certain of its members, who will look after said Districts, and assist the Secretary and Treasurer, so far as these are concerned, the Section Committees appointing their own District managers, and otherwise looking after the immediate business of their Sections. The Committees shall also appoint a Business Committee and any other Sub-Committees which they may consider advisable, and have full power to fill up vacancies in the General Committee and act for the Club (except to alter Rules), the majority in all cases to decide, the Chairman or President of the Club, however, having the power to appeal to a full Special General Committee Meeting. Proxies to be allowed at such Special Meetings only. That the Meetings of Committee be held on the first Thursday of each month, or as near that date as possible, at least two days' notice to be given by the Secretary when, together with other current business, the Minutes of the Advising Board and of the Business and other Sub-Committees, as well as the Treasurer's Financial Statement up to the end of the previous month will be read and considered.

XI.—That the Annual General Meeting be held early in September, and called by notice in at least one local athletic paper, and in one of the Glasgow evening newspapers not less than ten days before such meeting. The Reports of the Secretary and Treasurer

shall be submitted, and the Office-bearers and Committee (with Auditor to act in conjunction with one appointed by the Committee) appointed for the ensuing year. Twenty-five members shall form a quorum; a majority to decide. The Chairman shall have the power to appeal to a Special General Meeting on any special business, at which there must be fifty members, either personally or by proxy.

XII.—That a Special General Meeting may be called by the Committee, or by any ten members, or (in the above special case) by the Chairman on giving notice to the Secretary, who shall call the meeting in the same manner as the A.G.M.

XIII.—That these Rules be annexed to the Forms of Election and inserted in the Club's "Annual," and that no alteration in, or addition to, the Rules be made except at the Annual General Meeting, or at a Special Meeting called for that purpose. Ten days' notice of such alteration to be given to the Secretary.

Cross-Country Regulations.

I.—That Cross-Country Runs be held on Saturdays, from the 1st of October to the end of February, or on such dates as the Committee may fix.

II.—That the Club when out for a run shall be under the management of the Captain or Vice-Captain, or Senior Member of Committee present, who shall appoint a Pace-Maker, and Whip for the control of each pack.

III.—That no one, when out for a run, shall be allowed to go ahead of the Pace-Maker, unless the run be a racing run, or the signal be given by the Pace-Maker for a race home.

IV.—That every member of the Club is expected to wear the Club Uniform at the Club Runs, and to support the management for the time being.

V.—That Office-Bearers and Members of Committee wear distinctive badges at Club Runs.

NOTES

FROM THE

Eighth Annual Report of the Club.

THE Membership at last ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING, after making allowance for a large number of Members who had been struck off the Roll for non-payment of their subscriptions, totalled 921. Since that time, however, over 160 new Members have been added to the Roll.

The Reports from Dumbartonshire, Greenock, and Coatbridge Sections are of the most encouraging description, and everything points to a successful season in these districts.

The fixture card for last season contained Twenty-five Saturday Runs, in addition to which a New Year's Run, and weekly evening Runs took place; the attendance on

all occasions being most satisfactory. As in former seasons Badges were awarded to those Members who had attended every Run, and on this occasion the worthy recipients were Messrs A. Hunter and W. Wark of Headquarters, and J. Adamson of Dumbartonshire Section.

The Twenty Miles Cycle Handicap and Club Championship was again run on the Newton Mearns, Fenwick Road, on 8th October last, and received a fairly good entry. A. Burton was successful in winning the Handicap, while R. A. Vogt and D. E. Lacaille made a dead heat for Championship Honours.

The results of the Cross Country Handicaps, promoted by Headquarters during the season, were as follows, viz:—

Five Miles (Novice) at Rutherglen, won by J. Brickley; first man home, J. M'Gowan.

Five Miles (Open) at Govan, won by T. Mellis; first man home, J. M'Gowan.

Seven Miles (Headquarters) at Bishopbriggs, won by D. Crerar; first man home, J. Stavert.

Ten Miles (Open) and Club Championship at Cathcart, both won by A. Hannah.

Seven Miles Team Contest at Cathcart—1st, Coatbridge Section; 2nd, Captain's Team (Headquarters); first man home, A. Hannah.

In addition to these Handicaps the Sections also held several Confined Races, all of which were most successful, and were the means of unearthing some sterling runners, who, later on in the season showed good form on the path.

The Scottish Cross Country Union Junior Championship was held at Musselburgh on 4th February last, when the Club's Team, for the second time in succession, ran into second place, but we hope by next year to supply the winning six in this event. The Senior Championship was decided at Hampden Park, Glasgow, on 11th March, when we succeeded in retaining the honour with a total of 48 points; A. Hannah and P. T. Lewis being first and second respectively in the actual race. The other placed men in the Team were, in their order of merit, A. Russell, J. Marshall, G. Graham, and J. M'Gowan.

A Handsome Silver Cup has been presented by Mr. Andrew Dick of Mombasa, East Africa, who has so long taken such a deep and kindly interest in the welfare of the Club. The Cup is named the "Dick" Cup, and is to be held by the first man home in the Club's Team in the Senior Cross Country Championship each year. It has this year been fitly won by A. Hannah, who has so consistently and honorably upheld the reputation of the Club.

The Annual Sports were held at Ibrox Park on Saturday, 8th July, and a Supplementary Meeting was also held on the Monday evening following. Unfortunately the weather on both occasions, and especially on the Saturday, was of such an unpropitious nature as to almost completely spoil the attendance of the public. Great efforts had been put forth to make these Meetings worthy of the standing of the Club, the Prizes being of exceptionally high value, but owing to the adverse weather conditions, the Club was involved in considerable pecuniary loss; which, however, the Committee are hopeful of clearing off during the season. The athletic ability at these Meetings was, as usual, of a very high order, but in consequence of the sodden nature of the track, record performances could scarcely be expected. This notwithstanding, H. O'Neill of the Vagabond C.C., Dublin, equalled the existing half-mile record of 1 min. 10 secs., made on the same occasion last year by E. Leitch; while on the Monday evening, T. E. Messenger, of the Salford Harriers, and now a Member of the C.H., made a successful attack on the 220 yards record, which he lowered by $\frac{3}{4}$ secs. All the events were ably contested.

At the various Athletic Meetings held during the summer, our Members have, as in former years, been most successful, the Prizes won being greatly in advance

of past seasons. Championship honours are almost exclusively held by our Members. Prominent amongst these are A. Hannah, at whose credit stand the One, Four, and Ten Miles Flat Championships; A. R. Downer is in the unique position of holding the 100, 220, and 440 Yards Championships; W. Malcolm, the Half-Mile; J. R. Gow, 120 Yards Hurdle; and Hugh Barr, the Broad Jump; while in the Cycling world R. A. Vogt and J. M'Laren have worthily maintained their great names; the former being the holder of the One, Five, Twenty-five, and Hundred Miles Championships, and the latter the Ten and Fifty Miles Championships. In addition to these Vogt has accomplished many excellent performances, notably the records from Two to Five Miles (British), and Five to Ten Miles (World's) created by him at Herne Hill, London, in the early part of the season.

Badges for certain time performances on the track have been granted to D. R. M'Culloch, H. Barr, W. Malcolm, W. Gibson, and others. (See Conditions on page 48).

A Team consisting of Messrs Hannah, Robertson, and M'Laren, represented the Club in the "Davidson Trophy" Competition at the Heart of Midlothian F.C. Sports, on 24th June, which they were successful in carrying off, along with Badges presented by the Sports-holding Club. At Newcastle on 29th July, a Team of four, comprising

Messrs Hannah, Robertson, M'Laren, and Russell, took part in an Inter-Club Contest with the Newcastle Harriers, and on this occasion also, victory rested with the C.H. representatives, handsome Gold Badges for each of the Team accompanying a Silver Challenge Cup put up by the Newcastle Club.

It will thus be seen that the past season compares very favourably with any former ones, and in looking forward to the season upon which we have just entered, the Committee are hopeful that, as in former years, they will receive the encouragement and assistance of all the Members in their desire to further and strengthen the aims and objects of the Club, and that the enthusiasm and good-fellowship which has characterised the Club in the past may be continued in the future.
