CLYDESDALE HARRIERS.

Rules.

- I.—That the Club be called the “CLYDESDALE HARRIERS.”
- II.—That the object of the Club be the promotion of Amateur Athletics generally, and Cross-Country Running in particular.
- III.—That the general management of the Club be vested in a Committee not exceeding Twenty-Four Members, of whom Fifteen shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting of the Club, including, at least, a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Captain, and Vice-Captain; the remaining Members to be elected by the Committee and by the Sections (one from each Section). Seven Members to form a quorum.
- IV.—That each Candidate for election, upon filling up a form (on which the Rules of the Club are printed) declaring that he is an amateur, and that he will abide by the Laws of the Club and of the S.A.A.A., shall be proposed by one Member and seconded by another, after which his name will be submitted to the Committee, and, if agreed upon, passed. Any Member of Committee shall have the power of demanding a Ballot in the case of any Candidate. One black ball in four to exclude.
- V.—That the Annual Subscription for Ordinary Members be Two Shillings and Sixpence, payable on the 1st of October in each year; Honorary Members, Five Shillings; and that the Subscription for Life Members be One Guinea. New Members' Subscriptions must be paid within One Month from the date of notice from the Secretary that their application has been passed, otherwise their election may be declared null and void.
- VI.—That the Treasurer shall place before the Committee the names of all Members one month in Arrears for Subscriptions or other moneys, the Committee then having the power to erase the names of such Members from the Books, as well as to enforce payment of such Subscriptions, and no one whose Subscription has been allowed to fall in arrears shall be entitled to any of the rights and privileges of Members of the Club.

VII.—That any Member intending to withdraw from the Club shall give written notice to the Secretary before the Annual General Meeting, or be liable for another year's Subscription.

VIII.—That any Member violating the Rules of the Club or of the S.A.A.A., or doing anything prejudicial to the interests of either, may be expelled from the Club by the votes of two-thirds of the full Committee.

IX.—That the uniform of the Club be Black Knickers and White Jersey, and that the Club Badge (a Horn and Whip, with the motto, "Excelsior,") be worn on the left breast at Athletic Sports, and the Gate Badge on back at Cross-Country Runs. (Members are specially requested to enter under the name of the Club at Athletic Meetings.)

X.—That the Committee shall appoint an Advising Board of experienced members to confer with and advise the Secretary as to matters requiring to be dealt with by said Committee, and generally to watch over the interests of the Club. The Committee shall also allot the management of the Head Quarters' Districts to certain of its members, who will look after said Districts, and assist the Secretary and Treasurer, so far as these are concerned, the Section Committees appointing their own District managers, and otherwise looking after the immediate business of their Sections. The Committees shall also appoint a Business Committee and any other Sub-Committees which they may consider advisable, and have full power to fill up vacancies in the General Committee and act for the Club (except to alter Rules), the majority in all cases to decide, the Chairman or President of the Club, however, having the power to appeal to a full Special General Committee Meeting. Proxies to be allowed at such Special Meetings only. That the Meetings of Committee be held on the first Thursday of each month, or as near that date as possible, at least two days' notice to be given by the Secretary when, together with other current business, the Minutes of the Advising Board and of the Business and other Sub-Committees, as well as the Treasurer's Financial Statement up to the end of the previous month will be read and considered.

XI.—That the Annual General Meeting be held early in September, and called by notice in at least one local athletic paper, and in one of the Glasgow evening newspapers not less than ten days before such meeting. The Reports of the Secretary and Treasurer

shall be submitted, and the Office-bearers and Committee (with Auditor to act in conjunction with one appointed by the Committee) appointed for the ensuing year. Twenty-five members shall form a quorum: a majority to decide. The Chairman shall have the power to appeal to a Special General Meeting on any special business, at which there must be fifty members, either personally or by proxy.

XII.—That a Special General Meeting may be called by the Committee, or by any ten members, or (in the above special case) by the Chairman on giving notice to the Secretary, who shall call the meeting in the same manner as the A.G.M.

XIII.—That these Rules be annexed to the Forms of Election and inserted in the Club's "Annual," and that no alteration in, or addition to, the Rules be made except at the Annual General Meeting, or at a Special Meeting called for that purpose. Ten days' notice of such alteration to be given to the Secretary.

Cross-Country Regulations.

I.—That Cross-Country Runs be held on Saturdays, from the 1st of October to the end of February, or on such dates as the Committee may fix.

II.—That the Club when out for a run shall be under the management of the Captain or Vice-Captain, or Senior Member of Committee present, who shall appoint a Pace-Maker, and Whip for the control of each pack.

III.—That no one, when out for a run, shall be allowed to go ahead of the Pace-Maker, unless the run be a racing run, or the signal be given by the Pace-Maker for a race home.

IV.—That every member of the Club is expected to wear the Club Uniform at the Club Runs, and to support the management for the time being.

V.—That Office-Bearers and Members of Committee wear distinctive badges at Club Runs.

NOTES

FROM THE

Ninth Annual Report of the Club.

THE Membership presently stands at 837. Since last ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING a considerable number of Members have had their names expunged from the Roll, principally owing to the non-payment of their subscriptions, a most regrettable feature, but one which the Committee trust will soon disappear.

The Section Reports from Dumbartonshire, Greenock, and Coatbridge, which are of the most satisfactory and encouraging nature, show them to be in a perfectly healthy condition, and point to a season of unusual activity and success.

Beginning with the "Opening Run" at Maryhill Barracks, Twenty-five Runs—exclusive of a New-Year-Day-Run at Balloch, and the usual Weekly Evening Runs—were taken part in, the attendance on all occasions being well up to the average. Badges for attendance at all the Saturday Runs, were awarded to Messrs. H. D. Gow and D. Longmuir of Headquarters, and D. W. Mill and W. Colquhoun of Greenock Section.

Owing to the difficulties and restrictions connected with Road Racing, the Twenty Miles Cycle Championship and Handicap was run on the track of the Airdreconians F.C., which was generously placed at our disposal by that Club, and proved very successful. The Race resulted as follows:—

Five Miles (Novice) at Whiteinch, won by A. Forrester ; first man home, J. M'Gowan.

Five Miles (Open) at Cathcart, won by W. F. Wark; first man home, A. Hannah.

Seven Miles (Headquarters) at Thornliebank, won by George Brown; first man home, A. Hannah.

Ten Miles (Open) and Club Championship at Pollokshaws; Handicap won by A. Burton; Championship won by A. Hannah (the fifth year in succession).

Seven Miles Team Contest at Pollokshaws—First, Captain's Team (Headquarters); Second, Dumbartonshire Section; first man home, A. Hannah.

Several Section Handicaps also took place during the year, all of which received good Entries, and were well contested.

In the Scottish Cross Country Union Junior Championship, which was run from Hamilton Race Course on 3rd February last, the Team representing the Club succeeded in placing that honour to their credit, William Robertson gaining the title of Junior Cross Country Champion of Scotland. The other placed men in the Team were:—D. W. Mill, E. L. Kelly, R. S. Langlands, J. Stavert, and J. M'Gowan. The Senior Championship took place at Musselburgh on 10th March, and resulted in favour of

our Team—this being the third year in succession we have won the event. A. Hannah again successfully defended his title to the Individual Championship of Scotland, and was followed by:—A. Russell (5), W. Robertson (7), George Graham (9), E. L. Kelly (13), and P. T. Lewis (14).

A. Hannah, by being first man home in our Team, won for the second time in succession the "Dick" Cup, which becomes his absolute property should he again occupy the same position.

Our Annual Sports took place this year at Hampden Park—the Saturday Meeting on 30th June, and an Evening Meeting on the following Monday. The Sport provided on both occasions was such as ought to have secured one of the largest gates of the season, but notwithstanding a brilliant array of talent and excellent weather on the Saturday, the attendance of the public was disappointingly small, the consequence being a financial deficiency. On Monday the weather conditions were most unfavourable, and any opportunity that remained of recouping ourselves for Saturday's loss, was completely spoiled by rain. This bad luck has now attended us for three successive seasons, but we trust there are brighter days in store for us.

One of the most interesting events in connection with the Saturday Meeting, was the Inter-Club Team Race with the Newcastle Harriers (for Silver Challenge Cup presented for competition by them last season), when our Team, consisting of Messrs. A. Hannah, W. Robertson, A. Russell, and J. M'Laren, were successful in winning the Trophy for the second time, which, according to the conditions of contest, becomes our own property.

A month prior to this, we sent a Team to represent the Club in the "Davidson Trophy" Team Race at Heart of Midlothian Football Club's Sports at Edinburgh, when Messrs. W. Robertson, A. Russell, and J. M'Laren succeeded in retaining the Trophy.

During the Athletic Season, which has just closed, our Members have been highly successful, and their performances compare very favourably with former seasons. Amongst those we might mention the name of A. Hannah, who commenced the season by winning the Ten Miles Flat Championship, in, which he broke all existing records from six to ten miles inclusive, a success which he followed up by winning the Four Miles Flat Championship at the S.A.A.A. Meeting. At many of the Athletic Meetings held throughout the summer, the contests between Hannah and Duffus (also a Member of

the Club) will long be remembered, while W. Robertson proved himself no mean rival.

Badges for time performances (see conditions on page 46) have been awarded Messrs. A. Hannah and R. S. Langlands, while Hannah has also been granted special Badge for greatest number of Prizes won during the season, with 59 points; W. Robertson being second with 55 points.

It is satisfactory to be able to say that, notwithstanding its many difficulties, the Club continues to hold that high position in the Athletic world, which has so long been associated with its name, and that this position may be made lasting, the united efforts of the Members are earnestly solicited.
