## TRACK SEASON REGULATIONS AT SCOTSTOUN SHOWGROUND.

Hours 6.30 p.m.—9 p.m.

Entries for Events close at 7.30 p.m. on night of Event.

Track Events start at 7.45 p.m. prompt unless otherwise stated.

Field Events start at 7.30 p.m. prompt.

In the event of three or fewer entries in any one event no contest shall take place.

All boys under 15 years of age must be off Track, Tuesday and Thursday evenings by 7.15.

Spray-Room must be vacated by 8.45 p.m.

No trespassing on centre pitch.

A fee of 4d. will be collected from each member on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings.

Wednesday night is Youth Coaching.

Each evening the Club will appoint a Ground Steward to whom all queries should be addressed.

All members will adhere strictly to these regulations.

## CONSTITUTION AND RULES

1.—The Club shall be called the "VICTORIA PARK AMATEUR ATHLETIC CLUB."

2.—Its objects shall be the promotion of Track and Field Athletics and Cross-Country Running.

3.—The General Management of the Club shall be vested in a Committee consisting of the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Asst. Secretary, Treasurer and Social Convener, who shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting of the Club to hold Office for one year, the Captain, Vice-Captain and seven others, being elected bi-annually to hold office during the Track or Cross-Country Season, respectively, five to form a quorum, which Committee shall have power, if necessary to appoint any sub-Committee who may or may not be of their own number. No member shall hold more than one post on elected management.

4.—Life Membership may be awarded in the form of a Club certificate at the Annual General Meeting to any first claim member of the Club winning a National Senior Championship, establishing a Confirmed Senior Record, or any first claim member of the Club whose services to the Club, in the opinion of the Committee merit such an award.

5.—Honorary Membership shall be open to anyone interested in the welfare of the Club and shall be by an Annual Subscription of not less than £1 1/- . Honorary members shall not have voting powers.

6.—On the absence of any member of the Committee upon four consecutive occasions without adequate reason the said Committee will have power to elect another member to his place or to fill any vacancy which may occur in the offices of the Club.

7.—Each applicant for ordinary membership of the Club shall sign a declaration that he is an amateur in conformity with the definition adopted by the S.A.A.A. "An Amateur is one who has never competed for a money prize or a monetary consideration or for any declared wager or staked bet: who has never engaged in, assisted in or taught any athletic exercises as a means of pecuniary gain, and who has never taken part in any competition with any one who is not an amateur." This declaration shall be submitted to the Committee, and accompanied by the appropriate fee, which shall be returned if membership is refused.

8.—The Club subscription shall be Seventeen Shillings and Six Pence if 21 years of age and over, Twelve Shillings and Six Pence between 16—21 years of age, and Five Shillings if under 16 years of age. Subscriptions shall be payable on joining, and on 1st APRIL of each year thereafter. Any member intending to resign from the Club must give written notice before the Annual General Meeting, otherwise he shall be liable for a further year's subscription.

9.—Members serving in Her Majesty's Forces retain their membership while so doing, and do not pay an annual subscription until the DATE of their return to Club activities

10.—A member whose subscription is unpaid shall not be eligible to compete in club events.

11.—The Treasurer shall at required intervals review all subscriptions in arrears. Committee shall have power to transfer members whose subscriptions are more than one year in arrears, to inactive members list. Such members shall not be eligible to attend or vote at General Meetings.

12.—The responsibility of safekeeping the Club's Property and Finance shall be vested in a Property and Finance Committee elected by the General Committee of not less than any Four Members, two of whom shall be the President and the Treasurer. The Treasurer shall submit an audited financial statement half-yearly.

13.—Any member violating the Rules or doing anything prejudicial to the interests of the Club may be expelled from the Club by the votes of the majority of the Committee present and voting, after having been summoned and heard in his own defence.

14.—The Uniform of the Club shall be White Singlet with Royal Blue Hoops and White Shorts with Royal Blue Facings.

15.—In Club Championship or Group Standard Test Events the awards shall consist of Club Certificates. One Certificate only shall be awarded in each Group. In handicap events awards shall consist of prizes in kind.

16.—Entrance fees, may, at the discretion of the Committee, be charged in Club Competitions.

17.—The Annual General Meeting of the Club will be held in March. At the said meeting the Reports of the Secretary and Treasurer shall be submitted, and the office-bearers and Committee (with Auditor to act in conjunction with one appointed by the Committee), shall be elected. Twenty members shall form a quorum. A majority of members voting to decide. Only members, 16 years of age and over on date of Annual General Meeting shall have voting powers. In Committees and in General Meetings the Chairman shall have a casting as well as a deliberative vote. At least seven days' notice shall be given to all members of the Annual General Meeting, the Half-yearly Meeting and any Special General Meeting of the Club.

18.—The Secretary shall call a Special General Meeting of the Club on receiving a written requisition, signed by ten members stating for what purpose the meeting is required. Seven days' notice shall be given to members that such meeting shall take place.

19.—Any alteration or addition to this Constitution can only be made at the Annual General Meeting or at a Special Meeting called for the purpose, and then only if carried by a majority vote.

20.—Members proposing resolutions for the Annual General Meeting shall give notice in writing to the Secretary prior to 1st March.

21.—The Secretary shall have power to take legal action on behalf of the Club for monies due and in connection with all matters contained in the foregoing Rules.
