MACKENZIE RELAY TROPHY RACE.

The sixth annual race for the George Mackenzie Trophy attracted a record entry. Starting from Saville Terrace, the course was one of two and a half miles viz Alnwickhill Road, thence to Liberton Brae, returning by Liberton Dams, and finishing over 500 yards of stubble field. The weather was suitable for an event of this sort, but the going was heavy underfoot. On the completion of the first lap T. Glancy (E.N.H.) led from J. A. Henderson (E.S.H.). The positions were altered after the second circuit, R. Patterson (E.S.H.) winning from J. A. Sinclair (E.H.), while the Northern man captured the third place. The third lap saw the Southern again successful, and W. D. Patterson got off with a start of ten yards from J. L. Mackie (E.N.H.). Coming into view, the first three men appeared close together, but Patterson went ahead, and won from Mackie, with W. G. S. Moor close third.
