MIDLAND District 4x2½M Relay, Cleland, Oct. 31st. J. Stewart (V/Leven) led at the end of the first leg in 12.20 some fifty yards ahead of A. P. Brown (Motherwell) 12.29, with J. Johnstone (Monk. H.) 12.33 in third place. On the second stage A. H. Brown (12.17) gave Motherwell a 300 yard lead from G. Skinner of Shettleston (13.03). R. McKay and I. McCafferty increased the lead on the third and fourth legs to give Motherwell an easy victory and their fifth successive win in this event.

Eastern District Relay, Dundee, October 31st. Edinburgh South Harriers regained the Eastern title, beating the holders, Teviotdale, by about 100 yards with Edinburgh University a further forty yards back in third place. J. Douglas gave the holders a first leg lead of twenty yards from R. Coleman (Hawthill) with G. Brownlee (ESH) a further fifty yards behind. The second leg was a keen tussle between Ballantyne (ESH) and Raeburn (Teviot) with Ballantyne handing over just a yard in front. The third stage was also a very close affair with about ten yards covering R. McFall (ESH), P. Roden (Teviot), and A. Wight (Edin. Univ.) but a fine last leg of 13.31 by D. McGregor gave Edinburgh South victory in 56.02.
