## PLEBEIAN GAIN MIDLANDS RELAY CHAMPIONSHIP

### W. SUTHERLAND'S FINE FORM

The Midland District cross-country relay championship was decided at Hamilton Race-course on Saturday afternoon under good conditions. Plebeian Harriers, who had scored three victories in the six years of the race, were, as was generally expected, winners, Shettleston, the holders, being second, and Springburn third.

The Scottish 10 miles champion, W. Sutherland, gave Shettleston a fine lead over the first sector, but the novice, J. Whiteside, lost a lot of ground running against A. McGregor, and J. C. Flockhart was set an impossible task against S. K. Tombe. The latter, although evidently not fully wound up, held the six miles champion safely to give W. G. Black, the National novice champion, an easy run with J. C. Ross. He eventually broke the tape 120 yards ahead, with A. C. Montgomery, Springburn, the same distance behind Ross.

# PLEBEIANS' GOOD WIN

## Shettleston Take Second Place In Midlands Relay

**P**LEBEIAN and Shettleston, who have now won this race between them for the past five years, were again the principals in the Midlands District Ten Miles Relay Championship at Hamilton Park Racecourse on Saturday.

Plebeian's quartette were more evenly balanced than Shettleston (holders), the former club winning more comfortably than the 21 second margin would indicate.

As often happens, the leader in the first lap, W. Sutherland, Shettleston, recorded the fastest time, beating by two seconds, his clubmate, J. C. Flockhart, who earned this distinction in the two previous races.
