

Midland District Relay at Stirling, October 29th. Motherwell YMCA, with Ian McCafferty back in their team, simply ran away with the Midland Relay, finishing over two minutes ahead of Victoria Park for their seventh consecutive win. Alex Brown gave Motherwell a lead of almost 100 yards over Dumbarton's Graeme Grant on the first leg. The second stage saw Bert McKay increase the lead over Dumbarton to about 150 yards and on the final two legs they romped right away as Victoria Park moved to second and Dumbarton just held off Springburn's A. Middleton for third place.
