ARDEER WIN S.W. DISTRICT RELAY CHAMPIONSHIP

Annan Recreation Club interrupted Beith Harriers sequence of three successive victories by beating the holders into second place in the South - Western District cross-country relay championship at Stevenston on Saturday. The winners were given a lead in the first lap by Peter Alwell, who, incidentally, led Beith to victory last year, and ultimately finished forty yards in front of their rivals.
