

South-West District Relay, at Kilmarnock, October 29th. Glenpark won the South-West Relay for the first time since 1947 when they beat Wellpark by about 300 yards with the holders, Beith, the same distance further back, third. Glenpark held a thirty yard lead at the half-distance but a fine third leg by J. Spence increased their lead to nearly 300 yards, giving Dick Hodelet an easy task on the final leg despite T.
