EASTERN DISTRICT JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP.

The nineteenth annual junior championship of the Eastern District of the National Cross-Country Union of Scotland was decided at Portobello on Saturday, when 112 runners faced the starter. Teams were forward representing the following clubs, viz.:—Edinburgh Harriers (the holders), Edinburgh Northerns, Edinburgh Southern, Grange, Falkirk Victoria, Dundee Thistle, Gala Tavisdale, Kirkcaldy Y.M.C.A. Harriers, and Edinburgh University Harriers and Hounds. Harrier's Cross-Country Club, though unable to send a team, were individually represented.

A seven miles' course, mainly cross-country with heavy going, was laid from Portobello Higher Grade School to Craigmiller Castle, Newcraighall, and Brunstane as outlying points, with the finish at the west end of Portobello Public Park. The best man home was F. Dobbs, Grange Harriers, who won the individual championship in 43 mins. 28 2-5 secs.; 2nd, J. Danks, Falkirk Victoria Harriers; 3rd, J. L. Mackie, Edinburgh Northern Harriers; 4th, J. Spence, Falkirk Victoria Harriers; 5th, G. Hall, Grange Harriers; 6th, C. S. Brown, Edinburgh University Harriers and Hounds.
