EASTERN CHAMPIONSHIP

HONOURS FOR DUNDEE

A FIELD of 155 runners took part in the Eastern District Cross-Country Championship of Scotland, which took place at Dundee on Saturday over a course of approximately seven miles. Lord Provost Balfour started the race.

Alex. Hay, Dundee Thistle Harriers, won the individual championship in 41 mins. 59 secs. He finished 140 yards ahead of W. H. Whalley, Edinburgh University, whose time was 42 mins. 26 secs.

The team championship and the Fraser Memorial Trophy were won by Dundee Hawkhill Harriers.
