

Eastern District Champs., at Edinburgh,
January 16th. Fergus Murray (Edinburgh
Univ) won the Senior/Junior 6 miles in 29:12,
beating his captain R. Young by 15 seconds
with J. C. Douglas (Teviot) in third place.
Edinburgh University gained a comfortable
win in the team race with 61, their first win
in this event since 1956. Edinburgh A.C. won
the Youths team event with 6pts., F. Steel lead-
ing them home while T. McLennan (E.S.H.)

DOUBLE

After their overwhelming wins in the East District cross-country championships held from Newcraighall Pit Baths on Saturday, both Fergus Murray, who retained his individual title, and his club Edinburgh University, the new district team champions, should be full of confidence for their next major events—the Scottish Universities' title race on Saturday at Cambuslang, and the British Universities event at Nottingham, on February 6.

With six runners in the first sixteen places, the local students demonstrated their team strength in no uncertain manner to take custody of the Fraser Trophy for the first time since 1957 by a 67-point margin.

The district junior title goes to the Edinburgh University captain, Roger Young, who finished second in the senior race roughly 100 yards behind Murray. Results:
