



MIDLAND AND SOUTH-WESTERN CHAMPIONSHIPS.

Team and individual favourites for the seven miles Midland District championships were the day at Hamilton racecourse on Saturday. Plebeian Harriers, who were runners-up last year for the Maley Trophy, held by Shettleston Harriers, triumphed with a score of 103 points against 133 by Springburn. Shettleston comported themselves splendidly as a new team of juniors to finish third out of a company of 21 teams.

J. C. Ross, the novice and club champion of Shettleston, showed by his individual victory that he must be considered as a candidate for the Scottish team for Brussels. The race was at first a duel between Ross and J. Gillies, Shawfield. At the conclusion of the first circuit, Ross was in front and running comfortably, and three second-time round he got well clear.

SOUTH-WEST WINNERS.

Kilmarnock Harriers, in the South-Western District Championship, justified their position as favourites. They beat Doon Harriers with an aggregate of 136 points against 84. Eglinton were third with 136, but they had to fight hard to beat Glenpark by the narrow margin of 10 points.

Tod was responsible for securing a double event for the team-winners. He took command early, and, though W. O'Neill, Doon, tried to wear him down, he ran out a victor by the substantial margin of 120 yards.
