

TWO HARRIER TITLE RACES

Favourites Win Individual And Team Championships.

J. C. FLOCKHART, Shettleston, and **W. O'Neill**, Doon, were the respective winners of the Midland and South-Western District seven miles cross-country junior championships, held at Hamilton and Johnstone on Saturday. The team championships fell to Springburn and Eglinton, both clubs winning with many points to spare.

Flockhart was, by reason of his recent running, a hot favourite for the district honour. His victory over Jack Gifford, Victoria Park, was obtained in the easiest of styles. He had more than 300 yards to spare at the finish, in the fast time of 39 mins. 26 secs. J. J. McDonald, St. Peter's, ran well to finish third, 70 yards behind Gifford.

Springburn aggregated 85 points, a comparatively low total to beat Shettleston by 75 points, with Garscube third, aggregating 164 points. The Males Trophy goes to the winners.

O'NEILL IN CONTROL

W. O'Neill, Doon, was also favourite for the South-Western title. He never lost control of the race from Milliken Park recreation ground, to run out winner by 60 yards from W. Stevenson, Eglinton Harriers. J. M. Sellars, Paisley Y.M.C.A., was a good third.

Eglinton, like Springburn, won the South-West team race very easily, and their aggregate was even smaller. Their total was 60 points, or 53 fewer than that registered by Doon, who were again runners-up. Garscube were third with an aggregate only ten points more than Doon's.

C. D. AARVOLD DROPPED FOR IRISH GAME

The following have been chosen to represent England against Ireland in the International Rugby match at Twickenham on Saturday:

T. W. Brown (Bristol), L. A. Booth (Headingley), D. W. Burland (Bristol), R. A. Gerrard (Bath) and A. L. Novis (Army and Blackheath).

W. Elliot (Royal Navy and United Services) and B. C. Gadney (Leicester), D. A. Kendrew (Army and Woodford), G. G. Gregory (Bristol), N. L. Evans (Royal Navy and United Services), A. S. Roncoroni (Richmond), C. Webb (Royal Navy and Devonport Services), W. H. Weston (Northampton), O. L. Troop (Army and Aldershot Services) and E. H. Sadler (Army).

The selectors have made several changes, as was expected, from the team defeated by Wales at Twickenham. The most sensational is the dropping of C. D. Aarvold, the captain. A. L. Novis comes into the three-quarter line instead of Aarvold, while A. Key is dropped in favour of B. C. Gadney at scrum half. There are four changes among the forwards. Those dropped are A. Vaughan, Jones (who is ill), R. H. Black, R. Bolton and R. J. Longland.
