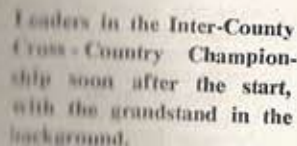
GUY BUTLER'S new film, "Athletics in 1963," is a typically comprehensive review of the past season—instructive to the coach and athlete and fascinating to all followers of the sport. Not surprisingly it is the

Not surprisingly it is the pole vault, that most eye-catching of all events, that attracts the most attention. Guy and his assistants have recorded on celluloid some very striking sequences of world record holder John Pennel in action. The shots, which are taken at normal speed, slow motion and double slow motion are absolutely fascinating not to mention breath-taking.

All the highlights of a great season are here: the world record relays, Frank Budd starting (this will set the coaches talking) and in full stride, the flowing grace of Henry Carr, the determination of Dorothy Hyman, the graceful hurdling and jumping of Mary Rand, and so on. Clubs can make a good story out of this.

Clubs can make a good start to the Olympic year's social activities by hiring this film, and it is perhaps appropriate to mention here that Guy Butler as well as being a first-rate cameraman is the most successful Olympic athlete in British history, having won four medals (including a gold) in the 1920 and 1924 Games.
