Camerons Win 5-Mile Title

The annual 5-mile team championship of the North of Scotland Amateur Athletic Association was held at Inverness on Saturday. In addition to the 5 mile race for seniors, there was a 3 mile race for juniors, and in all 30 runners took part, representing teams from Inverness, Forres, 1st Camerons Battalion, Cameron Depot, and R.A.F. Kinloss.

The team championship and trophy was won by the 1st Camerons, now stationed at Pinefield, Elgin, with 17 points, the runners-up being R.A.F. Kinloss, with 32 points.

Plaques were awarded to the first and second men home, and in the senior event the winner was Roy Brodie of the 1st Camerons, in a time of 25.30 mins., second was William Shearer, R.A.F. Kinloss (26 mins. 59 secs.), W. Ogilvie, Cameron Depot, being third in a time of 27 mins. 15 secs.
