

Clean sweep for East women

The East won all four team races in their annual women's cross-country match with the West at Dalkeith. The match was particularly satisfying for Edinburgh Athletic Club who supplied the individual winners in all but the senior race. Lorraine Johnston won the girls' one mile, Ann Lind, the junior two miles, and Lorna Inglis the intermediate three miles.

Only Moira O'Boyle (Victoria Park) disturbed the East domination and she swept to a convincing victory in the senior race with the field strung out well behind her. Second, over a minute behind, was Palm Gunstone (Dundee) with Eileen Brown (West) third. In spite of Moira's win, East took the team race 38-40 to make a clean sweep.
