## RACE INFORMATION

### REGISTRATION

Registration will take place in the Grandstand for both Club and Individual athletes. Team Managers or Captains must complete the BLUE declaration form and hand this in to the Registration Officials. Individual athletes must report to registration check point identified. All athletes must wear the number allocated to them in the programme on the FRONT of their Club Vest. Club Vests must be worn by all team members, failure to do so will lead to disqualification for team award. REGISTRATION CLOSES 2 pm.

### CHANGING FACILITIES

There will be two changing rooms. Athletes will be told which Dressing Room they should go to on Registration. The Loretto Boys School Gymnasium has plenty of room for changing, but limited showers and athletes are asked to be as economical as possible with hot water. SPIKED OR DIRTY RUNNING SHOES MUST BE REMOVED BEFORE ENTERING THE GYMNASIUM.

The Pinkie School Changing facilities are just two minutes away across the main A.1. road. Please be careful when crossing the road.

### WARMING UP

Warming up is strictly FORBIDDEN on the RACE COURSE, GOLF COURSE or PADDOCKS. A warm up area is designated on the course map and warming up is permitted in the Pinkie School playing fields. Please do not interfere with any of the Jumps or Hurdles in any way.

### RACE COURSE

The course is described on the race map and consists of two 5 kilometre figure eight loops. The start will be prompt at 2.30 pm and the Starter will line athletes up in club order across the race course. YELLOW NIKE TAPE WILL MARK THE OFFICIAL ROUTE. The S.S.E.B. have given permission for the course to circumnavigate the lagoons on the clear understanding that all athletes stay on the official course. Any athlete considering 'corner cutting' may never be seen again. When athletes return onto the race course at the start of the home straight they MUST KEEP TO THE LEFT HAND SIDE. The finish will be clearly marked in front of the Grandstand. NO ATHLETE MUST GO BACK DOWN THE COURSE WHEN THEY HAVE FINISHED.

### AWARDS

Scottish Cross Country Union Awards will be made to the first three athletes to finish, and also to the first three teams with three scoring runners. S.V.H.C. awards will be made to their members who finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each of the age group categories M.1. to M.9. subject to entries. Awards will be made at 4 pm.




