

PLEBEIAN HARRIERS' open road race for youths will be the feature of the cross country card to-morrow, when novices will be tasting club rivalry for the last time before they face the huge National field at Hamilton a week hence.

The Pleb. event, which is an open ballot team race, with three men to run and the same number to count in each team, is round the two miles 300 yards circuit of Glasgow Green and a start will be made at Greenhead Baths, shortly after three o'clock.

Of the few novice championships yet to be run, the most interesting may be Glasgow University's race at Garscadden, for it will reveal what progress has been made by J. Muir since he gave himself over to preparation for cross country work.

The services of Jim Flockhart, Shettleston Harriers and 1937 International Cross Country Champion, will be utilised by the I.O.G.T. Glasgow Central-Southern District Lodge No. 39, on Sunday, October 31, in the Robert Burns Hall, 379 Parliamentary Road, at 4 p.m. He will address the meeting on cross country running and Mr. Orton, his trainer, will also be present. The public are invited to attend.
