National Novice Championship.

The seventh annual novice championship of the Cross-Country Union of Scotland was decided at Bothwell, within the Policies, last Saturday, and was won by Garscube Harriers for the second year in succession. On going the final circuit S. Tombe, Plebian, had assumed command of the race, and eventually won in 26 mins. 38 secs. W. Gibson (Canon Club) was second, A. Lamont (Mauchline) third, R. Dyer (Shettleston) fourth, A. Allan (Plebian) fifth, and J. S. Smith (Dundee) sixth.

The team race resulted as follows:—1st, Garscube, 39 points; 2nd, Beith, 70 points; and 3rd, Plebian, 72 points.

R. Craigen, of the Motherwell Club, ran a very good race indeed, and finished ninth. The team aggregated 351 points, and tied with Glasgow Y.M.C.A. for 18th place. For Motherwell, J. Crabbe was second, D. Shaw third, and A. Bond fourth.
