## CHAMPIONSHIP FOR MISS BUCHANAN

Miss D. Greig (Tannahill), holder for the past two years, lost her Scottish women's title at Fauldhouse to Miss G. Buchanan (Western), runner-up last year.

Miss Buchanan's winning time was 16min. 41sec. for a course which was nearer two miles and a half than the stipulated distance of three miles and a half. Miss Greig was second in 16min. 48sec., Miss M. Crawford (Maryhill Harriers) third in 17min. 6sec., and Miss L. Inwood (Maryhill Harriers) fourth in 17min. 41sec.

Although those four runners, plus Miss C. Kelly (Maryhill Harriers) and Miss A. John (Edinburgh University) were named to constitute the team for the international meeting on March 9 at Richmond Park, London, the selection may be incomplete without Miss P. McCluskey (Rankin Park), a former champion and consistent performer until her failure to be placed on this occasion. Other results:—
