

# GEORGENA BUCHANAN WINS C.C. TITLE

The Scottish Women's Cross-Country Championships were run at Fauldhouse on Saturday, February 20th, in dry but bitterly cold conditions. The S.W.A.A.A. 880 yards champion and record holder, Georgena Buchanan, of Western A.C., won the Senior title in fine style by about 50 yards from Lesley Waters (Maryhill) in 23.29. The holder, Dale Greig of Tannahill, ran in third. Georgena led right from the start and although challenged first by Greig, and then by Watson, she held both of them off to regain the title she held in 1963. Maryhill were the easy winners of the team title for the fourth year running.

Marion led the field to within 20 yards from the finish, but collapsed and only managed to gain third place. Clubmate Linda Cherry was fourth. The Junior title was won by Margt. White. The Senior Championship was won by Georgina Buchanan, Western A.A.C., who covered the 3½ miles in 23 m.. 29 sec. Runner-up was Lesley Watson, Maryhill L.A.C. The previous holder, Dale Greig, Tannahill Harriers, who ran bare-footed, was third. Maryhill won the team race.

Mr Tam Dalyell, M.P., who started the first race, also presented the prizes. The Clerk of the Course was Mr W. Branwell, coach to the Fauldhouse Victoria Club.
