

## **Edinburgh to Glasgow Road Relay November 15**

**CAMBUSLANG** Harriers can now surely claim to be the team at the top in Scottish running. With the Western District and National relay titles already behind them, they added the prestigious Edinburgh to Glasgow Road Relay event to their list of victories on Sunday.

Edinburgh finished second despite Ferguson collapsing just short of the line with one lap still to go.
