ROAD RELAY RACE

ROUTE DETAILS

RACE STARTS AT 8.30 a.m.

1st Stage

Starting from Fettes College Gates in Carrington Road, run (on **RIGHT HAND SIDE OF ROAD**) straight ahead turning right into East Fettes Ave., then, **crossing to the LEFT HAND SIDE OF THE ROAD**, right into Comely Bank continuing forward on Craigleith Road and Queensferry Road to Barnton Roundabout turning left onto Maybury Road and, crossing **TO RIGHT HAND SIDE OF ROAD as instructed**, continuing to join the main Glasgow Road at Maybury Roundabout.

Distance 5.5 miles. Expected time of arrival 8.50am

2nd Stage

From Maybury Roundabout **STAYING ON RIGHT HAND SIDE** OF Main Glasgow Road (A8) continue (**WITHOUT GOING DOWN THE AIRPORT EXIT ROAD**) to Newbridge Roundabout (**crossing it by means of FOOTBRIDGE**) onto A89 under Viaduct and taking Right Fork onto A899 continue to BROXBURN Parish Church, **REMAINING ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE ROAD**

Distance 6.6 miles. Total distance 12.1miles Expected time of arrival 9.20am

3rd Stage

STAYING ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE ROAD Continue on A899 and A89 through Uphall and Dechmont (switchback going) to Livingston Station Road End.

Distance 4.7 miles. Total distance 16.8 miles Expected time of arrival 9.45am

4th Stage

STAYING ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE ROAD Continue on A89 through BATHGATE to Armadale **to NEW CHANGEOVER POINT - BUS SHELTER near house no 20 (ABOUT 100M BEFORE TRAFFIC LIGHTS)**

Distance 5.2 miles. Total distance 22.0 miles Expected time of arrival 10.10am

5th Stage

STAYING ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE ROAD Continue on A89 through Blackridge to former FORESTFIELD Hotel

Distance 5.6 miles. Total distance 27.6 miles Expected time of arrival 10.45am

6th Stage

STAYING ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE ROAD CONTINUE through Hillend and Caldercruix into AIRDRIE. **CONTINUE through the Pedestrian Precinct changing to the LEFT HAND SIDE OF THE ROAD** to the CHANGEOVER POINT AT THE **BUS SHELTER OUTSIDE AIRDRIE TOWN HALL**

Distance 6.3 miles. Total distance 33.9 miles Expected time of arrival 11.15am

7th Stage

ON THE LEFT HAND SIDE OF THE ROAD going round the inside edge of any roundabouts Continue on A89 through Airdrie to Coatbridge and, after passing through the ASDA Car Park Roundabouts turning left under the Railway Bridge (passing the Time Capsule) continuing to and through the Bargeddie Traffic Lights. Continue to Motorway Access Road and fork left for Baillieston. **At Baillieston TRAFFIC LIGHTS CROSS EDINBURGH ROAD INTO RAVENSWOOD ROAD (cross at will) turn RIGHT INTO BREDISHOLM ROAD and continue onto CHURCH STREET (again cross at will) then onto A89 (GLASGOW ROAD).** Change over is in the service road immediately after BANNERMAN HIGH SCHOOL.

Distance 6.0 miles. Total distance 39.9 miles Expected time of arrival 11.45am

8th Stage

From Change-over rejoin GLASGOW ROAD and turn left at TRAFFIC LIGHTS into Mount Vernon Avenue, **crossing when considered safe**, and turning RIGHT into Woodend Rd (**STAYING ON RIGHT HAND SIDE**), turn RIGHT into and cross Hamilton Rd **when it is safe**, turn LEFT into and cross Kenmuirhill Rd **when it is safe**, RIGHT into London Rd. **STAYING ON THE RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE ROAD** continue on London Rd and turn RIGHT into FIELDEN ST (**crossing as soon as it is safe**), LEFT into Crownpoint Road (**again crossing when it is safe**) and RIGHT into Cubie St which gives access to the track within Crownpoint Sports Complex running **clockwise on the Track to reach the Finish on the HOME Straight**

Distance 5.5 miles. Total distance 45.4 miles Expected time of arrival 12.15pm
