## Traditions Broken As Relay Title Goes West

THE SEVENTH Annual Scottish Six-Stage Road Relay Championships, sponsored by Glasgow Sports Promotion Council and held on March 31st, broke with tradition on three counts. Firstly, the race was held on a Sunday for the first time, secondly, the venue was moved from Strathclyde Park to Pollok Estate, and thirdly, the winners were a West of Scotland club, whereas previously the trophy had been monopolised by the Edinburgh clubs, with Southern achieving five consecutive wins and the AC gaining victory in last year's event.

A well-balanced Bellahouston team took full advantage of running on home territory to register an emphatic win over a weakened Edinburgh Southern team, with Spango Valley third. Unfortunately, the new course around the scenic estate and adjoining roads was not seen to its best advantage due to heavy rain throughout most of the race, which resulted in one particular downhill section, where the runners came off the tarmacadam path, developing into a heavy, muddy, cross country course.

On the opening short leg of 5000m, UK U/20 indoor 1500m champion, Brian Scally, quickly stretched out the field of 72 runners, with Peter

Faulds, David McShane, Tony Coyne and John McKay in close attendance. As Scally dropped back, Bellahouston's 'B' team runner, Graham Getty, who had steadily moved through, took his share of the pacemaking. However, going into the final half mile, 1500m specialist McKay was able to use his superior track speed to come home first in a time of 15:26, eight seconds ahead of the Falkirk runner Faulds, with the Bellahouston pair of Coyne (15:38) and Getty (15:39) waging their own private battle right up to the line. McShane of Cambuslang, fifth in 15:44, won the Junior duel from Scally by six seconds. Spango Valley and Edinburgh Southern, languishing in 22nd and 25th place, did not look likely medal contenders at this stage.

On stage two, the first long stage of six miles, 2:17 marathoner Andy Daly and Gordon Mitchell were soon locked together and initially seemed to be pulling away from their pursuers. Craig Ross, though had other ideas as he stormed round the course in 29:59 to take Dundee Hawkhill into a surprising lead, with Mitchell (30:39) holding on to second; while Daly (30:56), who had completed an 18 miles training stint the previous day in preparation for the London Marathon, was overhauled by Shettleston's Peter Carton (30:33). Southern and Spango were now 13th and 16th, but the most spectacular advance was made by Alan Puckrin, who moved Kilbarchan up from 39th to sixth place with the fastest time of the stage — 29:21. This performance eclipsed Alastair Douglas' creditable effort of 29:46, which had hoisted Victoria Park up 24 places to fifth.

Richard Barrie kept the blue and white vest of Dundee to the fore with a fine third leg of 15:31, while Kilbarchan were now second thanks to Scottish Junior CC champion Robert Quinn's fastest short leg of the day (15:08). Next came Falkirk, Shettleston and Bellahouston, who all dropped one place. Spango Valley in sixth place, were now in the reckoning through Peter Conaghan's nippy 15:26, with Edinburgh Southern 'A' tenth, only 21 seconds ahead of their 'B' team, for whom Wheeler had clocked 15:35, 65 seconds faster than his clubmate Kirk Smith.

Peter Fleming revitalized Bellahouston's challenge by recording the fastest time on stage four (29:32) and taking the Renfrewshire club into a clear lead over Falkirk, for whom John Pentecost had clocked 30:21. Kilbarchan were third through Gerry Fairley (30:38), with Lawrie Spence (29:43) improving Spango's medal prospects, as they now held fourth place. Veteran Brian Carty held on to fifth place for Shettleston with a commendable 31:11, ahead of Cambuslang's Eddie Stewart (29:45) and Southern's Evan Cameron (30:33).

On the final short leg, stage five, Alastair McAngus made amends for his disastrous run in November's Edinburgh to Glasgow Road Relay, when he consolidated Bellahouston's lead with the fastest stage time of 15:23 and the second fastest lap of the day. Although Falkirk held on to second, Spango's Terry Wilkie (15:56) had closed to within 23 seconds of the Eastern Region club. Kilbarchan dropped back to fourth, Cambuslang crept into fifth place ahead of Shettleston, with Southern still seventh. East Kilbride were poised just outside the top ten for the first time in the race due to an impressive 15:43 stint from the relatively unknown John McAllister.

There was no way George Braidwood could be caught on the final circuit unless he made a visit to the highly popular Burrell Gallery, which is situated within the estate. Braidwood cruised round the trail in a stylish 29:42 to give Bellahouston their first Senior Scottish title since the 1950s. Meanwhile, behind Braidwood a real tussle was taking place for second and third places. In spite of Falkirk and Spango having a cushioning lead of 106 and 83 seconds respectively over seventh placed Edinburgh Southern, they could not afford to be complacent as Allister Hutton was running his customary last leg. The Edinburgh man served up his usual brand of magic in this race to beam his club into second place with easily the fastest time of the day (28:25). Cammy Spence (29:58) snatched third place for Spango with his usual gutsy performance from Falkirk's Donald Bain (30:39). Cambuslang retained fifth place ahead of Kilbarchan, who recorded their best position ever in this event.


