Scottish Women's Road Relay Championships

Sponsors seem to be queuing up to back athletics these days. Sad to say that in a Scottish context therefore, it did not make for sense or success. On Sunday, with British Rail handing out £50 cheques for their Bathgate to Edinburgh road run PR exercise at Waverley Station, a number of the best Scottish women were conspicuously absent from the Post Office sponsored national event at Victoria Park.

A strong first lap from Sharon Sinclair in the senior women's event gave Irvine a first lap lead of 10 seconds over McLaren Glasgow's Audrey Sym. Jean Walker (McClaren) altered all that, taking the lead before 800 metres in her 2 mile stint and handing over a 20 second cushion to Lyn MacDougall while Pitreavie's Viv Alison had moved her team into second place.

MacDougall went on to produce the fastest lap of the day timed at 9:41.

McClaren Glasgow did what was expected of them in finishing first. Behind, Sue MacDowall (Pitreavie) held off a strong challenge from Irvine's Valerie Clinton to take second place. Irvine finished third.

The Ayrshire club proved to be the best of those in contention over the afternoon as a whole by taking two firsts and three third places home with them.
