

# HARRIERS.

EDINBURGH AND DISTRICT LEAGUE.—The second of four fixtures for the season of the Edinburgh and District Cross-Country League was run at Kirkcaldy on Saturday. The leading Edinburgh clubs were represented, viz.:—Edinburgh Harriers, Northern, Southern, University, Canon, and Heriot's, besides Kirkcaldy Y.M.C.A. There was a good entry, parents' cars being out on a five-mile route over road, plough and grass fields. The frost made hard going over the ploughed section, but good time was made, W. D. Paterson, of Southern, covering the distance first in 33 min. 54 sec. Results:—Edinburgh Northern, 33 points; Southern, 39; University, 49; Kirkcaldy, 68; Edinburgh Harriers, 72; Heriots, 113; Canon, 148. This result places Northern at the top of the League table, with Southern close behind. Mr Dickson, president of the National C.C. Union, was principal judge; Mr George Grant, secretary C.C. Union, referee; G. Sandilands, Kirkcaldy, starter; and G. Hume, secretary Scottish Amateur Athletic Association, timekeeper.
