## EDINBURGH LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP.

The third of four matches to decide the Edinburgh and District Cross-Country League Championship was run on Monday at Musselburgh over a seven miles course. Six of the seven clubs faced the starter, and about 120 men took part. Owing to another engagement, Edinburgh University, which held third place on the League table, did not turn out. After a double turn of the racecourse, the line was taken into the country. Two more turns of the racecourse gave the spectators a view of the hills when they again went into the fields. There was a double run home on the racecourse. Edinburgh Southern Harriers were left undisturbed at the top of the league, and the result was as follows:—1st, Edinburgh Southern Harriers, 2, 3, 4, 5—14 points; 2nd, Edinburgh Southern Harriers, 1, 9, 12, 14—36 points; 3rd, Edinburgh Y.M.C.A., 65 points; 4th, Edinburgh Harriers, 72 points; Heath's Cross-Country Club, 94 points; Canon's Club, 108 points. W. D. Paterson, Edinburgh Southern Harriers, was first home in 38 min. 24 3/5 sec., and he was 100 and 20 yards behind A. T. Armstrong, Edinburgh Southern Harriers, who was 200 yards ahead of F. Adison, Edinburgh Southern Harriers.
