

EDINBURGH DISTRICT LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP.

VICTORY FOR NORTHERN CLUB.

There were seventy runners engaged, and a fair turnout of spectators to watch the third and final race over six miles—to decide the Edinburgh and District League Championship at Musselburgh on Saturday. The race was run fairly well over the mountainous and partly serious country, and there was a double sandwich of turf and plough, with a finish on the narrowest straight. Mr George Hutton, Edinburgh Harriers, Mr G. M. Gray, Edinburgh Northern, and Mr B. Taylor, Heron's C.C. Club, were the timekeepers. The weather was dry and calm, though earlier rain made the going heavy. The first man home was B. Ross, Kirkcaldy Y.M.C.A. Harriers, in 28 min. 40 sec., with J. V. Wood, Heron's, and second race, and E. Finbow, Edinburgh Harriers, a good third. But a bunch of Edinburgh Northern men, running well together, inspired by their club the possession of the Sandilands Shield and the winning of the championship for the fourth successive year, the day's racing did not end after the League table position.
