SUCCESS OF NORTHERN

The third and final race of the Edinburgh and District Cross Country League was run at Kirkcaldy on Saturday, over a six miles' course. Edinburgh Northern again won the championship and Sandilands Shield. Ten teams took part in the competition, and the race resulted:—
