With a depleted team through sickness, the club competed in the second Edinburgh and District League Race at Musselburgh on Saturday last.

The weather was of a treacherous nature, wind, sleet, and rain blowing across the racecourse, where 100 competitors faced the starter.

Edinburgh Southern League leaders were strong favourites, but the University Hares and Hounds upset this forecast by defeating the Southern by 5 points, the navymen from Rosyth finishing 3rd with the Y.M.C.A. 4th, but finishing strong enough to hold 3rd position in the league. This performance by the junior members was a great achievement and should stand them in good stead when they compete in the Eastern District Championship at Galashiels on February 7.
