

CROSS-COUNTRY EVENTS

T. H. Braid (Edinburgh University) made a brilliant start to the cross-country season with an easy win in the first of the Eastern League races, over 4½ miles, at Liberton on Saturday. Braid allowed J. Smart (Edinburgh Southern Harriers) to make the early pace, but came away at the end to beat the S.A.A. half-mile titleholder by 50 yards. The students' team also won the team race.

Glasgow University defeated St Andrews University by 34 points to 44 in a cross-country contest over five miles at St Andrews. M. Durrington (St Andrews) gained first individual place, finishing in 33min. 50sec., more than a minute ahead of the Glasgow leader, J. M'Ghee. Details of other races:—
