EDINBURGH VARSITY WIN CROSS COUNTRY

The second race of the Eastern District Cross-Country League was run off at Kirkcaldy on Saturday. The race was held over a five mile course, starting and finishing at Bennochy Bridge.

Eight teams took part and the race was won by Edinburgh University who lost 45 points. Runners-up were Edinburgh Southern Harriers with 51 points. The other teams were placed as follows:— 3 Falkirk Victoria Harriers; 4 Edinburgh Eastern Harriers; 5 Edinburgh Rover Scouts; 6 Kirkcaldy Y.M.C.A.; 7 H.M.S. Caledonia; 8 Edinburgh Northern Harriers.

The individual placings were as follows:—1 W. G. Hunter, Edinburgh Southern Harriers (25 min. 9 secs.); 2 J. Brydie, Edinburgh University (25-19); 3 J. Jackson, Falkirk Victoria Harriers (29-20). The first Kirkcaldy runner home was P. Husband, a prominent member of the Y.M.C.A. team.

The battle at the top of the league is between Edinburgh University Hares and Hounds and Edinburgh Southern Harriers. As a result of their win on Saturday the University team now take over leading place from Southern, who now have lost four more points than the leaders.

The league placings to date are as follows: — Edinburgh University Hares and Hounds, 106 points; Edinburgh Southern Harriers, 110; Edinburgh Eastern Harriers, 234; Falkirk Victoria Harriers, 274; Edinburgh Rover Scouts, 298; Kirkcaldy Y.M.C.A., 367; H.M.S. Caledonia, 428; Edinburgh North Harriers, 519.
