

# To-morrow's Cross-Country Racing

Edinburgh and District Cross-Country League will hold their first race of the season over a 4-mile course from King's Buildings, Edinburgh, to-morrow. The clubs engaged will be Edinburgh Southern, Edinburgh University, Eastern, Falkirk Victoria, and probably Edinburgh Harriers. The recently affiliated club, Braidburn, may also be represented. As usual, Edinburgh University and Edinburgh Southern are expected to figure prominently in the finish.

In the West, all the Lanarkshire clubs, including Springburn, Shettleston, Monkland, Hamilton, and Motherwell Y.M.C.A. will compete at Coatbridge for the county championship. Cambuslang won the event last year, and from all accounts they have a good chance of retaining the title. Springburn should do well with such strong runners as P. M'Farlane, J. O'Hare, D. Harold, and R. Gaw. M'Farlane, who has been making fine progress in recent months, finished sixth in the National Youths' championship at Hamilton last March. In addition to the team event there will be the Lanarkshire youths' relay championship.
