

Cross Country Race City Team Wins At Kirkcaldy

THERE was a strong **Edinburgh** representation in the ten teams which competed in the Eastern District **Cross-Country League** race at Kirkcaldy on Saturday afternoon. Leading places in the event — the second of the season—were taken, in the main, by teams from the city. **Edinburgh** Southern claimed premier place and consolidated their position in the **league** lead against the challenge of **Edinburgh** Eastern and **Edinburgh** University, who were in the third and fourth positions on Saturday.

The starting signal for the five-mile race was given by Bailie A. Fleming. The start, from Bennoch Road, was delayed, although when the teams assembled no time was lost.

The first runner home in a race which culminated in a keen finish in Balsusney Road was I. Morrison, Braidburn Athletic Club, who completed the course in 24 minutes 12 seconds.
