## FALKIRK VICTORIA HARRIERS.—

On Saturday last Falkirk Victoria Harriers continued their steady progress of the past season when, for the first time since the war, they gained second place in the first race of the Eastern District League. The race was held at Kirkcaldy and the Vics had four men in the first thirteen in a field of approximately 200. A Crawford was second, being beaten by inches by A. Jackson (Edinburgh University), Eastern District champion Team captain and coach D. Cleland brought the team along nicely and, thanks to his tactics, R. Sinclair (eleventh), P. Paterson (twelfth) and himself (thirteenth) gave Falkirk a grand chance. When T. Todd, after doing the pace work for the team, finished twentieth and A. Cook thirty-third, much improved on last year second team place was assured. The second string also packed well to force some of their rivals back to even bigger totals.
